Post Office

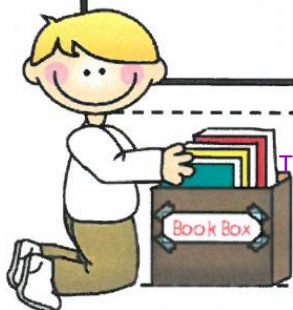
This month, we will set up a post office. The children will be encouraged to deliver messages and pictures to each other. This is a significant way for the children to experience the importance of both giving and receiving.
